Here are some reflections from our 2016 Year 13s telling us of their experiences:

**Ryan King:** Wow, what a year! I can definitely say that 2016 was the greatest year of my life so far. I loved absolutely everything about Year 13 - the people, the lectures, the solo time with God, and just getting to hangout and live with my brothers and sisters. And they really are my family. My friends in blue stream are the most amazing people I've ever met. I can't really pick one highlight, just the whole year. But one thing that definitely stands out is going to Fiji. I had the opportunity to see a community centred on Jesus bloom and flourish. I made (eternal) lifelong friendships.
