BIBLE SOCIETY TURNS 200!

I remember early last year the urgency of a letter I received from Keith Wilson, a faithful servant of our Lord. As only the Spirit prompts, Keith was very concerned about the ministry of the Bible Society and the importance of 'handing on the baton'.

Praise be to God for his timing as Greg McCarthy now is our KAC Bible Society representative. Today you will hear from Greg at all our services as the Bible Society celebrates 200 years of Bible ministry in Australia.

In March 1817, Governor Lachlan Macquarie signed the Bible Society into being. The Bible Society has played an active role in translating and enabling the Bible to be made available to five billion people worldwide today! Beyond the major world languages, the Bible Society supports the ongoing task of translating the Bible into sign language and the indigenous languages of our nation.

Local area representative, Barbara Mathie from Gerringong, shares... 'The money raised during the 200th year for the Bible Society "Get the Word Out" fundraising campaign will go to three areas of their mission within Australia:

- 1. The Big Rescue Bible for Primary School children, as well as a version suitable for High Schoolers.
- 2. Funding for Indigenous Bible translation work.
- 3. Bibles for Chaplains to use in hospitals, prisons and amongst the Australian Defence forces.

In Kiama there will be a Bible Society youth focus with a special event to be held on **Saturday**, **1**st **April**, **from 2pm to 5.20pm for 200 minutes**. It will take the form of a gathering in Coronation Park (Surf Beach). The young people will be asked to form teams, according to the number present, and fun activities and challenges will be organised by the youth leaders of Gerringong Uniting. This will be similar to those organised last November at the Bible Society youth event hosted at the Church Point Centre.

At about 4.15pm the young people will be asked to form into three groups and each group will form either a '2', a '0' or a '0'. This will then be photographed as a '200' human formation. Watch out for local youth in 'The Sower' and possibly even 'Eternity' magazines!

The Bible Society is also offering an opportunity to celebrate their 200th birthday during 2017 by giving people access to a free Bible to give to a friend, a person you are sharing Jesus with, people in your workplace/family life - anyone who needs to know the God of the Bible. Check out the Bible Society website for further details!

We thank God today as we celebrate God's grace and mercy and the gift of his Word, the Bible.
