I have worked in education for most of my professional life, first as a classroom teacher, then as an advisor and university lecturer. Once my three kids had grown and flown, I went overseas to work in emergency education. I worked in a series of crisis areas including Rwanda, from which we developed protocols and strategies for dealing with situations of conflict and crisis through to Afghanistan and Bangladesh with the Rohingya, and most other conflicts of the last twenty years. My most sustained piece of work during this time was a Peace Education Program which was implemented in 17 countries and, apparently, is still being implemented in various countries. I finished my career in Jordan developing another peace education program for teachers and students. I am also the coordinator of the ESL program sponsored by KAC; we run three classes a week, all on Monday evening, for beginners, citizenship and advanced (which is mostly Bible Study). I organise the teaching resources and the teachers' roster as well as teaching together with the team.

Previously (for over two years) I also looked after the Green Connect permaculture vegetables pickup. This has now ceased as Green Connect have a stall at the Wednesday markets and do home deliveries.

I do small service in Covid-cleaning in Christ Church and in being part of the welcome and Communion clean-up service rosters for the 8am service.

My faith is probably more pragmatic than 'devout' (I cannot quote Biblical verses as often as I would like). But I truly believe that, when we are at our best our every action, both small and large, and our service to the community demonstrates our 'life in Christ'.
