



Full-time Ministry Role Assistant Minister

Kiama Anglican Church (KAC), an evangelical church in the Illawarra region of NSW, is seeking to expand its ministry team and appoint an Assistant Minister.

Our KAC Mission is *“To glorify God, making Jesus known as we love and serve together”* and our Vision is: *“We are prayerful, intergenerational, and connected, being transformed by Jesus.”*

To facilitate achievement of our vision, we seek to equip people to follow Jesus and serve our community.

We meet across two sites at Kiama and Minnamurra. Each Sunday we have five services, ranging from a traditional 8am service, a Contemporary Service at 10am, a loosely structured under 40's (family) meeting at 4pm and an all age service at 6pm at Kiama. There is also an 8:30am service at Minnamurra

Additionally, there are a multiplicity of Growth/Bible Study Groups and prayer meetings throughout the week. KAC also has activities reaching into the community such as playgroup, school SRE, and special events which seek to support and involve the wider community.

The basic requirements of a ministry role are:

- Completion of an accredited theological degree, preferably ordained
- Current Safe Ministry Training
- Working With Children Check
- Evidence of 4+ years' active effective ministry leadership and Christian maturity

We are seeking people who are:

- Committed to ministry in a local church
- Excited when people come to find hope and purpose in knowing Christ
- Team players, who share with courage and accept direction humbly, while using unique gifting to complement the gifts of others
- Passionate about teaching the Bible
- Aligned with an evangelical, biblical world view
- Servant hearted i.e. preach, teach and be hands on
- Able to lead volunteers and participate in outreach and pastoral ministry
- Caring, encouraging, well organised and diplomatic
- Keen to minister intergenerationally

- Innovative in reaching people with the gospel
- Leaders in their current church
- Sensing that Kiama may be where they can serve

If you were successful in joining the ministry team at KAC you would:

- Grow and develop further your ministry gifting
- Preach on a regular roster, based on the current series focus
- Contribute to the development of Bible study material for Growth Groups
- Lead Bible study(s)
- Participate in primary school SRE classes
- Take particular responsibility for one of KAC's Sunday gatherings at Kiama and mentor leaders
- Participate in and lead community outreach events
- Pastorally support KAC members of all ages
- Conduct other occasional services and provide pastoral support to those involved
- Participate in and lead the development of fresh strategies to reach various age groups and cultures
- Ensure continuing growth in your own walk with Jesus

If you believe Kiama may be where you could serve, please write to us and tell us about your motivation, relevant experience and underpinning qualifications.

Your expression of interest will be treated in confidence, however, if we proceed with your application, we will ask that you provide the names and contact details of three people you have worked with and with whom we can speak to better understand your experience, competency, personal character traits and spiritual gifts. One referee should be your current Senior Minister.

The selection process will involve several informal and other more structured steps. We want to ensure you and KAC are the right fit. We are praying that the people of God's choosing for our ministry team become evident, perhaps it's you!
