BIBLE STUDIES

For parallel studies this term, we will use ‘**Mark - Follow Me**’ by James Hoover in the *Life Guide Bible Study Series*. These were used in Term 1 2025, and this year we fill in the gaps.

We still have plenty of copies and they are available in the foyers. If you would like to cover the cost of your booklet, you may do that by placing \$12 in an appropriately marked envelope or transfer with a reference of, ‘Bible Study Book.’

The study passages do not line up with the sermon passages. Each group can handle that in the way that suits them, but here is one simple approach to cover the studies and (more or less!) match the Sunday passages.
